






King Room Standard Garden View

Morocco's history is a fascinating tapestry woven from the influences of various civilizations, dating back thousands of years. The region was originally inhabited by Berber tribes as early as 8000 BCE. These indigenous people, known for their resilience, have significantly shaped Morocco's cultural identity.

Throughout its early history, Morocco was influenced by several empires, including the Phoenicians and Carthaginians. However, the arrival of the Romans in the 2nd century BCE left a more lasting mark, as Morocco became part of the Roman province of Mauretania Tingitana. Roman influence persisted until the fall of the empire in the 5th century CE, when the region fell under the control of the Vandals and later the Byzantine Empire.
